Wet2Dry makes use of absorbent fabric technology

Lissen Marschall, the founder of Siccaro, is the daughter of the inventor Peter Marschall, who created the original 'Buster' collar, the famous protective plastic cone collar, which is still used worldwide today. In 2012, Lissen set out to find an absorbent textile for the hairdressing industry, yet after creating the super-absorbent fabric technology, called Wet2Dry, she realised it would be far better to create a drying robe for wet and cold dogs.

Wet2Dry is the key textile which makes the Siccaro Supreme Pro robe, a super-fast, hands-free way to dry your dog so that your dog is warm, dry and relaxed following exercise, training, or working out in the countryside.



Using the robe alleviates joint issues later in life because moisture is drawn away from the skin and muscles of



the dog while it simultaneously stays warm. It also means the end of wet dogs in your home and car, and no more smelly wet towels to launder after drying them.

Lissen commented: "When we launched the Siccaro Supreme Pro robe, the field trials community were rather reluctant about putting 'clothing' on their dogs." Now, a few years later, along with many fantastic responses from vets, breeders, gun dog trainers, the police and army canine units, the Siccaro dog-drying coats are regarded as an essential, hugely beneficial and time-saving tool when dealing with cold and wet dogs.
